The Tootsie Roll Drive is the largest fundraising project for the Knights of Columbus of the year. Proceeds (100%) go to Cardinal Centers First Steps Program and Kosciusko County's Special Olympics. Last year 165 volunteers from the Knights, Sacred Heart Church, CCI, Kohl's, and Scouts raised over \$19,400. We meet at the garage south of the Parish Office on Lindberg Street about 15 minutes prior to the start of a shift and will take volunteers for any amount of time that can be donated. Suggested shift times are listed below. We typically collect the most on Friday evening shift and have the hardest time getting help on Saturday afternoon. Street shifts are the most profitable due to the traffic flow and you must have a valid driver's license to collect on the street. **Feel free to call Steve Sudhoff (267-6061) to sign up for a shift or catch the display in the foyer and sign up after Mass.**
